Chairman Byrd opened the floor for Public Input. The following spoke.

## Anita Adams, 233 Mt. Calvary Road, Clarkton, NC 28433: stated the following:

- 2. We have sent out invitations for the groundbreaking ceremony on January 14, 2016, at 11:00 A.M.:
- 3. I would like to tell you that we have been able to do a lot of things with the support of this Board and the citizens of Columbus County;

- 4. We provided Christmas for nine (9) children;
- 5. We did a surprise Christmas party for the homeless veterans at the Ashley House in Wilmington; and
- 6. A big thank you for everything that you have done.

## **Agenda Item #7: MENTAL HEALTH - UPDATE:**

Victoria Jackson, Chief of Clinical Operations, delivered the following annual update on Mental Health to the Board.

- 1. I want to deliver you some updates on mental health in the area;
- 2. I am a licensed clinical social worker and I have been this for about thirteen (13) years;
- 3. Eastpointe is a managed care organization for behavorial health;
- 4. We serve people who receive Medicaid and state funding;
- 5. We are a managed care organization for mental health, substance abuse and intellectual development disabilities;
- 6. We are regulated by the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services and we also have a credit advise which means we cannot mess up our rules;
- 7. We cover twelve (12) counties at the present;
- 8. We have a team of clinical staff and a team of medical doctors that review;
- 9. Our member call center is for twenty-four (24) hours, and we handle all crisis calls that come in and folks who are at want of services; **and**
- 10. We have a Mental Health First Aid and a Crisis Intervention Training for law enforcement.

## **Questions / Discussion:**

**Vice Chairman McDowell:** How many clinics do you have that are close to or in Columbus County?

**Victoria Jackson:** replied stating Primary Health Choice, Monarch, Advantaged Behavioral and Dixon, our HNH Service.

Vice Chairman McDowell: Are they funded by you, or do they just receive funding?

Victoria Jackson: They are contracted by us.

Vice Chairman McDowell: Does Eastpointe work with the City of Whiteville schools?

Victoria Jackson: Yes.

**Commissioner Prevatte:** Many changes have occurred since the LME's and the MCO's have started. In Columbus County, we do not have a walk-in clinic, and people in need do not know where to go to get help.

**Victoria Jackson:** In Columbus County, we have Monarch which is a walk-in clinic for mental health located on 626 South Main Street. The workshop is located at 207 West Walter Street. Monarch is not a twenty-four (24) hour clinic.

**Commissioner Prevatte:** This information has not been advertised. Discussion is underway relative to providing office space to be used for those in critical need.

**William S. Clark, County Manager:** We would like some statistics on Columbus County, how many people are being served?

Estimating 4 persons per home and multiplying by 19,855 homes = 79,420 citizens whose household electrical needs are served using renewable energy produced in Columbus County. As the population of Columbus County is approximately 58,000, the County may be considered as a new exporter of electricity.

Annual Revenues from Personal Property Taxes on Solar Farm Equipment are estimated at .2 x \$238.65 MM x \$8050/MM = \$384,226.50. A significant increase in the real estate taxes for land used for solar farms will also be realized as land is moved from farm or timberland exemption status to full tax value land used for an industrial application.

We have received from Austin Consulting a Shovel-Ready Designation Award Letter for the food and beverage industry at the Southeast Regional Park Site.
