

Columbus County Accepting Proposals for VHF Simulcast Paging System

Vendors are invited to submit a proposal to design, furnish, install and commission a new VHF simulcast paging system. The paging system will be used to alert fire and emergency medical services personnel. Columbus County seeks proposals that will provide a state-of-the-art public safety paging communications system providing the highest level of quality and performance.

All proposals must be submitted no later than 3:30pm local Eastern Time on March 2, 2017. Proposals must be submitted by this deadline; no exceptions will be allowed.
