AR 1 - Adult Airway	Added Midazolam 2-2.5 mg IV/IO Repeat every 5 minutes as needed. Use only with definitive airway in place.
AR 3 - Airway, Drug Assisted	Removed Optional Protocol
AR 5 - Pediatric Airway	Added Midazolam 0.1-0.2 mg IV/IO Repeat every 5 minutes as needed. Use only with definitive airway in place.
AR 6 - Pediatric Failed Airway	Added the BIAD of choice for pediatrics is the KING airway
AR 8 - Post intubation/BIAD Management	New Protocol. Ketamine removed, Propofol removed and Vecuronium removed
AM 6 - Suspected Stroke	New Protocol. Added MEND is the prehospital exam Columbus County uses
PM 1 - Pediatric Allergic Reaction	Added Pepcid is the histamine blocker of choice. Children age 1-16 receive .5 mg/Kg up to 20 mg IV/PO. Children less than 1 year old receive .5 mg/Kg, PO only.
TE 7 - Overdose/Toxic Ingestion	Added if more than 2 mg of Narcan (Naloxone) needed call Medical Control for additional

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
