It was also ordered at this meeting that a notice be printed in the newspaper setting out the days on which persons from certain townships should appear before the Board and that the list-takers for the various townships be summoned to be present on the respective day in order to aid in the tax adjustments. It was understood by the members of the Board that all tax matters relative to 1929 valuation should be adjusted on these days, otherwise the Board will not entertain a complaint filed by any taxpayer at a later meeting.
