Orders other than the foregoing changes in valuations and irregularities which were passed on the date of this meeting are as follows:

A motion was made by H. G. Avant, seconded by J. C. Hooks, Sr., and motion was carried to hire out George Pierce to his brother, Scrap Pierce, upon payment of costs of Court, said Scrap Pierce to make bond for his brother, the said George Pierce. All costs are to be paid within six months.

Ordered: That the money which the County will receive from the gasoline tax as collected from the State Highway Commission be applied to the road and bridge bonded indebtedness and interest thereon of the County again this year as was the case during the fiscal year 1929-30.

Ordered: That J. J. Harrelson of Clarendon be admitted to the County Home.

After hearing Dr. Branch of the State Health Department in regard to the County appropriating a budget from which to pay the expenses of a dental clinic for the school children of the County, the Board of County Commissioners ordered that \$900.00 be included in the Cooperative Health budget for the year 1930-31 in order to meet the expenses of the said dental clinic for schools.

Ordered: That the Cooperative Health budget of \$5,000.00 be allowed for the year 1930-31 provided that the State will appropriate the amount of \$2,100.00 toward said budget.

Ordered: That the Employers' Compensation insurance carried by the County proper be divided this year on a 50% basis between McDaniel-Boice

Insurance Agency and Ammons and Burns Insurance Company.

Ordered: That D. F. McGougan and H. G. Avant be appointed a committee to buy or make whatever contract they deem necessary and advisable regarding the purchase of road equipment; said committee to report as to what action had been taken at the next Commissioners' meeting to be held on Monday, July 7, 1930.

There being no further business to be transacted by the Board at this time, adjournment was voted in order until Commissioners' next regular meeting to be held on Monday, July 7, 1930.
