

Orders other than the foregoing changes in valuations and irregularities which were passed on the date of this meeting are as follows:

A motion was made by H. G. Avant, seconded by J. C. Hooks, Sr., and motion was carried to hire out George Pierce to his brother, Scrap Pierce, upon payment of costs of Court, said Scrap Pierce to make bond for his brother, the said George Pierce. All costs are to be paid within six months.

Ordered: That the money which the County will receive from the gasoline tax as collected from the State Highway Commission be applied to the road and bridge bonded indebtedness and interest thereon of the County again this year as was the case during the fiscal year 1929-30.

Ordered: That J. J. Harrelson of Clarendon be admitted to the County Home.

After hearing Dr. Branch of the State Health Department in regard to the County appropriating a budget from which to pay the expenses of a dental clinic for the school children of the County, the Board of County Commissioners
