Ordered: That bid of Columbus County in the case Columbus County vs F. E. and Laura Williams be transferred to A. B. Bordeaux for a consideration of \$20.00.

On motion of C. D. Garrell seconded by D. W. Merritt it was ordered that the County pay Premium on bond for Deputies for Tax Collector.

Whereas, The State Highway Commission under an Act of the General Assembly of 1931 will take over all county roads and Chain Gangs on July 1; and

Whereas, the Chain Gang of Columbus County is now engaged in improving a County road from Hallsboro to the Bladen County line near Elkton; and

Whereas, only fifteen or twenty days additional work will be required by the Chain Gang to complete the work on which it is now engaged; and

Whereas, said road is an important one connecting State Highways # 20 at Hallsboro and State Highway # 211 at Elkton;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that the State Highway Commission be requested to use the County Chain Gang for a period of fifteen or twenty days beginning the 1st of July to complete the improvement now in progress on said road.

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution be sent to District Highway Engineer, Morson, Wilmington, N. C., and a copy recorded upon the minutes of this Board.
