

Columbus County held by the said Bank for safe keeping, to the Wilmington Savings and Trust Company, Wilmington, N. C., and the said securities are to be held by said Wilmington Savings and Trust Company for safe keeping, and are to be delivered only to the Chairman and Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners upon written receipt of an order directing said Chairman and Clerk to have said securities delivered to them.

Ordered: that Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, designated depository of the County of Columbus, be required to immediately deliver to Wilmington Savings and Trust Co, Wilmington, N. C., State, Federal, or County bonds, or notes of Columbus County payable to Bearer at said Waccamaw Bank and Trust Co, in the sum of \$60000.00 as security to the deposit or deposits of Columbus County in said Waccamaw Bank and Trust Co, The Said bonds are to be held by said Wilmington Savings and Trust Co., as such depository bond, and shall not be delivered to any person or persons, except upon receipt of a certified copy of a resolution duly adopted by this Board and signed by the Chairman and Clerk, ordering the delivery to said Chairman and Clerk, either in person or by mail.

Ordered: that the Chairman and Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners be directed to obtain and deliver receipt for \$60000.00 Columbus County notes now held by North Carolina Bank and Trust Co., the said notes to be delivered in person to said Chairman and Clerk to Board, the said \$60000.00 having been previously placed with North Carolina Bank and Trust Company by Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company as a depository bond, or for a guarantee of any deposits said County might have in said Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company.

Minutes of the last meeting being read and approved, the following business was transacted:

Ordered: that Charles Cobb be admitted to the County Home.

Ordered: that Mildred Rogers be appointed Registrar of Vital Statistics of Fair Bluff Township in place of B. H. Small who resigned.

Ordered: that the sum of \$5.00 only be paid for the capture and delivery of a complete whiskey still after investigation by said Board that it is bona fide made. This order is to supercede all other orders heretofore made relative to the capture of whiskey stills. If a court conviction is rendered, \$10.00 will be paid.

Ordered: that F. B. Richardson, Coroner, be notified that hereafter no mileage will be paid to any Juror unless said Juror is summoned in the immediate community where the killing was or inquest held.

Ordered: that the News Reporter Co. and the Columbus County News be requested to make sealed bids on County advertising and printing for the next twelve months on or before first Monday in August.

Ordered: that the Tax Collector be instructed to issue Peddler's license to H. M. Bullard to peddle in Columbus County when he presents note signed by himself and endorsed by Jesse F. Bullard due and payable September 1st, 1933.

Ordered: that Sallie Russell be allowed \$2.00 present relief and \$2.00 per month.

Ordered: that Tax Collector accept Extended School term voucher made payable to Zara Butler for \$33.10 to be applied on 1932 tax of T. H. Williams.

Ordered: that the automobile used by the White Home Demonstration Agent be advertised on week to be sold to the highest bidder for cash at the Court House door on first Monday in August 1933.

Ordered: that the County Attorney foreclose A. S. Richardson real estate mortgage to Columbus County.

Ordered: that D. L. Gore, Tax Collector, and Julian D. Lewis, accept in full settlement for all back taxes prior to 1932, the actual taxes less penalty cost, interest, and a discount of ten per-cent.

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Ordered: that R. M. Anderson of Fair Bluff N. C. be granted license to sell beer in Columbus County at place designated on application.

Ordered: that the Department of Health vouchers be signed for payment.

Ordered: that the following resolution be recorded, relative to borrowing Sixty Five Thousand (\$65,000.00) Dollars for General School purposes, and Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars for General County purposes, same being renewal notes.

Be It Ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that two notes of the County of Columbus for General School purposes be executed, one in the sum of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars, and one in the sum of Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars, dated July 30th, 1933, maturing November 1st, 1933.

Be It Further Ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that two notes of the County of Columbus for Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars each, and one for Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars, for General School purposes be executed dated July 18th, 1933, maturing November 1st, 1933.

Be It Further Ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus For General County purposes be executed in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars, dated July 18th, 1933, maturing November 1st, 1933.

All of the above said notes bearing interest at the rate of (6%) six per-cent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said notes payable to BEARER at Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company of the city of Whiteville, N. C., in anticipation of 1933 taxes, and that said notes be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said notes at maturity.

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County has had it brought to it's attention by certain citizens of Columbus County that a paved highway connecting Loris South Carolina with Tabor North Carolina is very much needed, and that the distance of this project in Columbus County, North Carolina is only three-fourths mile and that the asphalt plant is set up in a distance of two-tenths mile of said project and the Board feel that at this time it will be most economical and essential to hard surface this small project while said plant is located at Mount Tabor, North Carolina;

Now, therefore, Be it further resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that the State Highway Commission be requested to hard surface this three-fourths mile of road which will connect Loris South Carolina with Tabor, North Carolina which is a distance of about six miles and the present mileage is about fifteen miles.

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution be sent to the State Highway Commission at Raleigh and a copy be recorded on the Minutes of this Board.
