Whereas, it appears that the said road which it is desired by said citizens that the Highway Commission take over is the short link of three-eighths of a mile of the old abandoned highway between Powell's store and the Whiteville and Clarkton Highway north of Powell's store, this being a very much used and needed link in getting from Happy Hill section to Highway, or visa versa, and too, the road equipment travels this link each week going to and from one road to the other now maintained by the State, therefore it would be no extra cost to the State to keep up this link.
