The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office October 2nd, 1933, it being first Monday. Members of the Board present:

Minutes of the last meeting being read and approved, the following business was transacted.

Ordered: that J. E. Mills be refunded 1933 Poll tax on account of his drawing Federal Compensation.

Ordered: that D. P. Ward be allowed \$5.00 to pay hospital expense for Mrs. D. P. Ward.

Ordered: that D. M. Brown's 1930-1931 and 1932 taxes be separated so R. H. Colvin may pay his part on 24 acres which he holds mortgage on, which with his proportional part of personal tax is \$21.20 for 1930, \$11.20 for 1931, and \$16.01 for 1932.

Ordered: that the time for Bondsmen of Bank of Columbus paying their notes and mortgages to Columbus County be extended to first Monday in November 1933.

Ordered: that Robert L. Welburn, disabled World War Veteran, be granted license to peddle in Columbus County for thirty days from this date.

Ordered: that C. D. Garrell, Chairman, be authorized and empowered to cancel of record, deed of trust of D. M. Thompson and wife who are Bank of Col. Bondsmen. Said deed of trust is being paid with \$2,645.67 Columbus County bonds.

Ordered: That no coffins be delivered except for dead at County Home, Jail, and outside poor list.

Ordered: that no amount be appropriated to Relief work from the 1933 Budget to be spent through the Welfare Department of Columbus County.

Ordered: that the Board of Health vouchers be signed.

Ordered: that the Tax Collector be notified to advertise 1932 unpaid land taxes to be sold first Monday in November 1933.

Ordered: that 1931 Land Sale Certificates be transferred from D. L. Gore, Tax Collector to Julian D. Lewis, Attorney, for collection as required by law.

Ordered: that Tax Collector accept 1932-1933 school vouchers on payment of 1932 taxes.

John W. Hall, Sheriff, tendered his bond in the sum of \$5,000.00 with the Fidelity and Casualty Company of N. Y. as surities, approved accepted and ordered recorded, C. D. Garrell, R. C. Benton, and W. L. Hobbs being present and voting therefor.

Ordered: that F. L. Cartrett be allowed \$5.00 present relief to pay on hospital bill.

Whereas, certain citizens of South Williams township, Columbus County have petitioned the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County to request the State Highway Commission to improve the Class "C" Road beginning at the North edge of the town of Tabor, North Carolina and running parallel with the A. C. L. Railway Company to S. F. Willoughby's home, same being a distance of about one mile; and,

Whereas, the said citizens ask that the same be made at least a Class "B" Road,

Now, therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that the State Highway Commission be and it is hereby requested that the said road be improved and made at least a Class "B"

Road; and,

Be It further resolved that a copy of this resolution be sent to the State Highway Commission in Raleigh and a copy recorded on the Minutes of this Board.

Whereas, certain citizens of Lees Township have requested the Board of County Commissioners to recommend the taking over and maintaining of a certain road in said township by the State Highway Commission; and,

Whereas, it appears that the said road which it is desired by said citizens that the Highway Commission take over is a road beginning at Shiloh Methodist Church situated on New Britton Ferry or Mark Pine public road leading in an easterly direction to Honey Field public road about three quarters of a mile with the Honey Field road about south to New Britton Ferry public road about one mile;

Now therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that the State Highway Commission be and it is hereby requested that said road be added to the State Highway System and maintained; and,

Be It further resolved that a copy of this resolution be sent to the State Highway Commission in Raleigh and a copy be recorded on the Minutes of this Board.
