Ordered: That A. W. Baldwin, County Auditor be instructed to notify all parties that are due Columbus County money on notes and mortgages to pay interest, and principal if possible by February 1st, 1934 or foreclosure porceedings will be started.

Ordered: That under the provisions of H. B. 1665, 1933 General Assembly, entitled "An Act Authorizing the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County to Accept Settlement for Past Due Indebtedness," this Board hereby authorized the acceptance of any Columbus County bonds maturing on or before February 1, 1944, in payment of any and all notes and mortgages due Columbus County, the said bonds to be received at par value and credited on said notes at par value.

Ordered: That R. B. Mallard be appointed as Attorney for Recorder's Court for a period of six months at a salary of \$50.00 per month.

Ordered: That Register of Deeds be instructed not to charge for certifying to contracts for leases of land when needed for tobacco contracts.

Ordered: That That Bond Interest & Redemption Fund voucher for \$39,953.47 be allowed and paid to take care of Principal and interest due on bonds payable at Central Hanover Bank and Trust Company, New York, N. Y.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, adjournment was voted in order until Monday, January 1, 1934.
