Ordered: That R. T. Bruton be appointed Register of Vital Statistics in place of W. H. Shelly who died.

Ordered: That W. B. Best tract of land in Bug Hill Township be sold to L. Baggett at \$50.00.

Ordered: That order passed February 5th, 1934 renting D. C. Gore the Raleigh Register tract of land in Bug Hill township be rescinded on account of D. C. Gore representing to the Board that land had been abandoned by said Register.

Ordered: That Raleigh Register be allowed to pay \$75.00 in full settlement of his taxes in Bug Hill township for 1931 and all prior years for the sum of \$75.00.

Ordered: That Mrs. W. R. Carter be allowed \$2.00 present relief and \$2.00 per month.

Ordered: That on motion of W. L. Hobbs and seconded by C. A. Small, that J. P. Bahson be allowed to settle his note and mortgage to County and also his 1931-32 and 1933 taxes with \$2500.00 Columbus County Bonds. It is further ordered that C. D. Garrell, Chairman be authorized to cancel said mortgage of record and sign voucher to pay said taxes.
