The following business was transacted:

Ordered: That 656 acres tract of land valued at \$9,000.00 listed in the name of G. M. Jolly in Williams Township for year 1923 be separated so P. W. Ray may pay taxes on 365 acres valued at \$6,000.00, which said P. W. Ray now owns.

Ordered: That F. B. Foster be given contract for plumbing work at County House as per specifications, his bid being the best at \$135.00.

Ordered: That Wacc. Lbr. Corp. be allowed to make notes for 1930 & 1931 taxes due Columbus County without paying their 1932 taxes on account of a loan being in progress from the R. F. C.. It is further ordered that no foreclosure action be taken on 1932 taxes before October 1st, 1934.

Ordered: That H. H. Horton be given contract for wiring at County Home as per instructed at his bid of \$19.50.

T here being no further business to come before the Board at this time, adjournment was voted in order until April 2nd, 1934.
