The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office October 1st, 1934, it being first Monday. Members of the Board present:

Minutes of the last meeting being read and approved, the following business was transacted.

Ordered: that T. B. Creech Estate 84 acres tract of land for 1933 be separated so W. J. Creech, Edna Creech, and W. E. Barnhill can pay their equal part of taxes which is one-third each.

Ordered: that A. P. Worley be allowed to pay \$35.00 in full settlement of taxes charged against Lucy Blackwell in Cerro Gordo Township for 1930 and all prior years.

Ordered: that H. M. Long's 20 acres tract of land valued at \$200.00 be reduced to \$100.00 for 1934 and future years.

Ordered: that the Register of Deeds be allowed to extend credit to the Wilmington Production Credit Corporation on thirty days basis for recording their papers.

Ordered: that the plans submitted by Mrs. Agnes Barnhardt to this Board be accepted for a T. B. Ward to be constructed on County Home Property.

Ordered: that the Co operative health vouchers be countersigned.

Ordered: that J. E. Harrelson be allowed to pay \$33.75 in full settlement of his taxes for 1929-1930-1931-1932, and 1933. Cancel 1929 and 1930 and pay 1931 and 1932 at par and add interest for 1933 with \$6.00 court cost.

Ordered: that the settlement of D. L. Gore, Tax Collector, be accepted upon the recommendation and report of D. N. Blue, Auditor, for the years 1932 and 1933, and that the 1934 tax books be turned over to said Tax Collector for collection. It is further ordered that the two bonds of said Tax Collector, dated October 23, 1933 continue in force according to the terms and stipulations of said bonds.

Ordered: that 1932 tax sales certificates be turned over to J. D. Lewis for collection or foreclosure under the same terms and conditions as previous certificates have been turned over.

Ordered: that Pick Strickland's note for \$40.00 given for rent of Williamson land be delivered to J. C. & J. R. Williamson.

Ordered: that Lewis Melvin be granted refund on 1934 Poll tax.

Ordered: that note dated July 12th, 1934 for \$2500.00 due October 9th, 1934, and also note dated August 12th, 1934 for \$4000.00 due November 8th, 1934 be cancelled and destroyed. These notes were issued for General School Fund to repair school buildings but were not approved by Local Government Commission. Said two notes were destroyed by C. D. Garrell, Chairman.

Ordered: that Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, Receiver for J. C. & J. R. Williamson, be refunded taxes on \$1705.00 for 1933 and \$1705.00 for 1934 on account of being penalized for both years.

Ordered: that C. G. Goins 55 acres tract of land in Chadbourn Township be reduced from \$2600.00 to \$2375.00.

Whereas, certain citizens of Columbus County have petitioned the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County to request the State Highway Commission to place the road leading from Fair Bluff to Tabor in the State System:

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that the State Highway Commission be and it is hereby requested to place the said road in the State System; and,

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution be sent to the State Highway Commission in Raleigh and a copy be placed on the minutes of this Board.

Whereas, certain citizens of Tatum Township have petitioned the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County to request the State Highway Commission to grant a road in said township; and,

Whereas, the road which it is desired by said citizens that the State Highway Commission grant is the old Evergreen Lumber Company tram road, a distance of about two miles, being from Mack Lennon's, the Evergreen and Bladenboro road, to Floyd Singletary's, the Chadbourn and Bladenboro road:

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the County Commissioners of Columbus County that the State Highway Commission be requested to grant the above described road; and,

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution, together with the petition, be forwarded to the State Highway Commission in Raleigh and a copy be recorded on the Minutes of this Board.

Whereas, certain citizens of Columbus County have petitioned the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County to request the State Highway Commission to open and maintain the road from Fruit Ridge to Dyson and Walker Crossing, Crossing, the same being on the north side of the Atlantic Coast Line Railroad and used as detour when Route No. 20 was under construction:

Now, therefore, Be it resolved that the State Highway Commission be requested to take over and maintain the above described road; and,

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution, together with the petition, be sent to the State Highway Commission in Raleigh and a copy be recorded on the Minutes of this Board.
