The following business was transacted;

Ordered: that Woodrow Ward be allowed to pay his 1930 taxes in Williams Township without paying the \$6.00 court cost.

Ordered: that W. C. Gore Estate in Lees Township be allowed to pay 1930 taxes without paying court cost.

Ordered: that T. H. Williams be allowed to pay \$100.00 in full settlement of Mary J. Knowles and J. A. Knowles taxes in Ransom Township for years 1925 to 1934 inclusive, which the said T. H. Williams now has title for.

Ordered: that Mrs. Edith A. Garrell lot in South Williams

Ordered: that the County provide County's part of required salary to pay a George Reed Home Economics teacher for the Tabor High School.

Ordered: that Supplement Budget for 1934-1935 of Board of Education be approved in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars to pay for school trucks and busses.
