Ordered: that the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars for General School purposes, same being renewal note.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General School purposes be executed, in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars, dated January 10th 1935, maturing July 10th, 1935.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of six (6%) per cent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, of the City of Whiteville, N. C. in anticipation of 1934 taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.

On July 10th, 1935 the County of Columbus for value received, promises to pay to the BEARER hereof at the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, of the City of Whiteville, N. C., the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars with interest at six (6%) per-cent per annum from date.

This note is issued in accordance with the County Finance Act and in pursuance of a resolution duly adopted by the Board of Commissioners of County of Columbus on the 27th day of December 1934, and duly assigned by the Chairman and Clerk of said Board as required by law.

It is hereby certified and recited that each and every act, condition, and thing required to be done, to have happened, and to be performed, precedent to and in the issuance of this note, has been done, has happened, and has been performed in full and strict compliance with the Constitution and laws of the State of North Carolina and that this note is within every debt and other limit prescribed by law, and that the faith and credit of the County of Columbus are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of this note, according to its terms.

In witness, whereof, the County of Columbus has caused its Corporate name to be signed hereto by the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners and the Corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and attested by the Clerk to the Board of Commissioners, this the 27th day of December 1934.
