Ordered: that Marshall and Robert Shipman be allowed to pay 1932 and prior years taxes by paying 10% flat.

Ordered: that the County sponsor a project to drain the White Marsh and J. K. Powell, Attorney, be authorized to secure necessary blanks for filing said application. It is further understood and agreed that this project will be no expense to the County.

Ordered: that the Chairman be authorized and instructed to sign three project proposals with the Works Progress Administration which are submitted by Mrs. E. K. Proctor to this Board at this meeting, of which copies are filed with the Clerk.
