APPLICATION RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION NO. 1

A resolution authorizing Columbus County, North Carolina, to file an application to the United States of America through the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works for a loan and grant to aid in financing the construction of a County Home Building for Columbus County, named and described in Exhibit "A", hereto attached and described in Exhibit "A", hereto attached and designating A. W. Baldwin, Clerk to the Board of Commissioners, to furnish such information as the Government may request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County, North Carolina:

Section 1. That the project described in the schedule hereto attached and designated as Exhibit *A* is necessary in order to support, maintain and properly care for the poor of Columbus County.

Section 2. That A. W. Baldwin, Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners, be and he is hereby authorized to execute and file an application in behalf of Columbus County to the United States of America for a loan and grant to aid in financing the construction of a County Home Building for Columbus County, named and described in the schedule hereto attached, designated Exhibit "A".

Section 3. That A. W. Baldwin, Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County be and he is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the United States of America, through the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works, may resonably request in connection with said application, which is herein authorized to be filed.

It is ordered by the Board that Leslie N. Boney, architect of Wilmington, N. C. be employed to prepare plans on the County Home Program and that the preliminary plans presented to the Board be approved and accepted andthat L. N. Boney be paid 6% of total cost of County Home building for preparing plans, supervising work and all services in connection with it as required by the W. S. Government, compensation to be paid only in the event that the project is approved by the P.W.A. of the U. S. Government.

It is ordered by the Board that W. H. Powell and Julian D. Lewis be and they are hereby employed as attorneys for Columbus County to do and perform such services as are required by the P.W.A. of the U. S. Government. In connection with the issuance of bonds and building of the County Home project, W. H. Powell and Julian D. Lewis are to be paid 1% of the total amount of cost of project in the event that project is accepted and approved by the U. S. Government.
