Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General County purposes be executed in the sum of Nine Thousand (\$9,000.00) Dollars, dated January 1st, 1937, maturing July 1st, 1937.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of 3 1/4 per cent per annum,

interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to Farmers and Merchants Bank, in the City of Fair Bluff, in anticipation 1936 taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.

Be it further ordered that the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.

On July 1st, 1937 the County of Columbus for value received, promises to pay to the BEARER hereof at the Farmers and Merchants Bank, of the City of Fair Bluff, N. C., the sum of Nine Thousand (\$9,000.00) Dollars with interest at 3 1/4 % per annum from date.

This note is issued in pursuance of a resolution duly adopted by the Board of Commissioners of County of Columbus on the 18th day of December, 1936, and duly signed by the Chairman and Clerk of said Board as required by law.

It is hereby certified and recited that each and every act, condition, and thing required to be done, to have happened and to be performed precedent to and in the issuance of this note, has been done, has happened, and has been performed in full and strict compliance with the Constitution and laws of the State of North Carolina and that this note is within every debt and other limit prescribed by law, and the faith and credit of County of Columbus are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the Principal and Interest of this note, according to its terms.

In witness whereof, the County of Columbus has caused its corporate name to be signed hereto by Chairman Board of Commissioners and the corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and attested by Clerk to Board of Commissioners, this the 18th day of December. 1936.
