The following business was transacted.

On motion of W. L. Hobbs, seconded by W. M. Stephens, the following resolution was adopted.

Pursuant to an Act of the General Assembly of 1937 providing for an election for the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County hereby respectfully requests the County Board of Election, after due advertisement, to call an election according to the provisions of said Act, it being House Bill # 55 enacted by the General Assembly of North Carolina 1937 Session.

Ordered: that the Tax Listers of the various townships be paid 10¢ for each tax list and 5¢ for each farm report, and he be paid \$3.00 per day for meeting with Assessors.

Ordered: that the township Tax Assessors be paid \$3.00 per day for their services and be paid 5¢ per mile for travel where actually needed.

Ordered: that H. G. Avant, W. M. Stephens and A. W. Baldwin be appointed as a building committee for new County Home.

Ordered: that A. W. Baldwin, Auditor, deliver to Jackson Greer Sr., County Attorney, the real estate mortgage executed by L. C. Harper and wife to the Trustees of School District #11 for foreclosure.

Ordered: that \$55,000.00 Columbus County note now in the Wilmington Savings and Trust Company made payable to BEARER at Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company and held by Wilmington Savings and Trust Company placed there by Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company as security for deposits in said Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company be released, and in lieu thereof, renewal note in the sum of \$55,000.00 be placed with said Wilmington Savings and Trust Company in place of the said sum of \$55,000.00 in notes, said renewal note dated January 14, 1937, maturing July 14, 1937.

Ordered: that the following returns of an election for issuance of Columbus County Home Bonds for the erection of a County Home, held March 9, 1937, be recorded.

Ordered: that Rolard Baldwin be allowed to pay Thomas Claridy tax at par and \$3.00 Court Cost.

Ordered: that S. B. King Estate/^{taxes}in Ransom be paid at par plus two per-cent and no court cost, on account of D. L. Gore failing to credit said tax with payment.

RESOLUTION

Ordered: that the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.00) Dollars, for General County purposes.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General County purposes be executed, in the sum of Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.00) Dollars, dated March 17, 1937, maturing May 17, 1937.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of six (6%) per-cent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at the Cabarrus Bank and Trust Company, Concord, N. C. in anticipation of a Bond issue and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.
