APPLICATION FOR GRANT

The Board of Commissioners of Columbus County, Whiteville, N. C. (herein called the "Applicant"), hereby makes application to the United States of America through the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works (herein called the "Government"), for a grant for the purpose of aiding in financing the construction of A GENERAL HOSPITAL TO BE BUILT IN THE TOWN OF WHITEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA, WHICH IS THE COUNTY SEAT OF COLUMBUS COUNTY, herein called the "Project" the total cost of which is estimated to be \$99,976.03.

In the event this application is approved and the Government offers to assist in financing the construction of the Project, the Applicant, if it accepts such offer, will provide funds in an amount which, together with the Grant, will, in the judgement of the Applicant and the Federal Emergency Administrator of Public Works, be sufficient to construct the Project, such additional funds to be provided by the Applicant in an amount and in a manner satisfactory to the Applicant and to the Administrator.

It is expressly understood that if the Government makes the above-requested grant, the Applicant, in accepting such grant proceeds, in expending the same, and in carrying out the construction of the Project, will abide by all rules and regulations prescribed by the Government.

Ordered: that the Tax Collector issue license to W. A. Wier to retail beverages as provided in the "Beverage Control Act of 1933".
