Baldwin, Clerk to the Board of Commissioners, communicate at once with the P.W.A. authorities in Atlanta, Ga. requesting them to extend the grant for the Columbus County Hospital for 60 days from November 18th, 1938, for the reason that the Bond Attorneys have refused to approve the election held September 26th, 1938, and made certain recommendations relative to issuing bonds.

It is ordered that Jackson Greer, Attorney, prepare and file suit and prosecute same in the Superior Court in the matter of the Columbus County Hospital.
