NOW, THEREFORE, it is resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that application be made to the Public Works Administration for an extension of time for the completion of said hospital, said time to extend until November 17th, 1939.

RESOLUTION

Ordered: that the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars for General School purposes.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General School purposes be executed in the sum of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars, dated July 1st, 1939, maturing November 1st, 1939.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of 1% per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at Wachovia Bank and Trust Company, Winston Salem, N. C. in anticipation of 1938 taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus

Be it further resolved that the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.

REVENUE ANTICIPATION NOTE

The County of Columbus, in the State of North Carolina, hereby acknowledges itself indebted and for value received promises to pay to the BEARER hereof in lawful money of the United States of America the sum of

\$20,000.00

on November 1, 1939, together with interest thereon from date hereof at the rate of 1% per annum, payable upon presentation of this note at its maturity. Both principal of and interest on this note are payable at WACHOVIA BANK AND TRUST COMPANY, WINSTON SALEM, NORTH CAROLINA. For the prompt payment hereof, both principal and interest as the same shall fall due, the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus are hereby irrevocably pledged.

This note is issued pursuant to the County Finance Act, as amended, and a resolution duly adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of said County for necessary expenses and for the purpose of meeting appropriations of the current fiscal year.

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED AND RECITED that all acts, conditions and things required by the laws and Constitution of North Carolina to be performed, happen and exist precedent to and in the issuance of this note have been performed, have happened and exist, and that this note is within every debt and other limit prescribed by said laws and Constitution.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the County of Columbus has caused this note to be signed by the Chairman of its Board of Commissioners and attested by the Clerk of said Board and its corporate seal to be impressed hereon, this 1st day of July, 1939.
