RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, bids for EQUIPMENT have been received pursuant to due and legal advertisement therefor, and have been opened, read and tabulated;

WHEREAS, it has been recommended by Leslie N. RESOLUTION

Ordered; that the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing (\$25,000.00) Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars for General County Purposes, same being renewal note.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General County purposes be executed in the sum of Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars, dated November 30th, 1939, maturing May 30th, 1940.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of (1½%) One and one-half per cent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at Wachovia Bank and Trust Company, Winston Salem, N. C. in anticipation of 1939 taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General County Fund
