Ordered: that Adeline Gilispie's 1940 and prior years taxes be separated so Etta May Mitchell may pay 1/3 and Rosa Waring may pay 2/3 of said taxes as they own said property.

Ordered: that L. D. Hardee be refunded 1940 Poll tax on account of living in South Carolina, if he furnishes satisfactory proof that he has moved to S. C.

Ordered: that check received from Bladen County for \$20.00 for care of Ola Mae Savage of Bladen County for month of August, be deposited in General County Fund.

Ordered: that Mrs. J. R. Nunn be authorized to purchase material needed for N.Y.A. work at County Home.

Ordered: that A. T. Green's 1932 taxes be separated so he may pay his personal tax and tax on 65 acres of land, other land tax belongs to I. L. Green which is charged to A. T. Green.

Ordered: that Mrs. J. F. Rogers 1930, 1931 and 1933 taxes be sep arated so Geo. D. Strickland may pay tax on one lot at \$50 which he owns.

Ordered: that A. F. Powell be allowed to pay J. J. Bowen's 1928 to 1934 tax at \$540 valuation by paying 6% flat and 1/2 court cost.

Hinson, be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that the overdraft in the amount of \$9,838.91 charged to the Bolton Drainage District be charged off and the Bolton Drainage District be no langer charged with this overdraft or held liable for the same in accordance with previous resolution adopted by a former Board of County Commissioners of the 17th day of February, 1936.

It is further ordered that the tax receipts now held by the Tax Collector of Columbus County charged to various taxpayers in the Bolton Drainage District be collected as the law provides and the funds deposited to the credit of the General Fund of Columbus County, but in the event the Bolton Drainage District levies any furure taxes, these future taxes be collected as provided by law and turned over to the said Drainage District.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General County purposes be executed in the sum of Twenty Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars, dated September 30, 1940, maturing January 30, 1941.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of 1 3/4 % per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at Wachbvia Bank and Trust Company, Winston Salem, N. C. in anticipation of 1940 taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.

Be it further ordered that the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.

It is hereby certified and recited that each and every act, condition, and thing required to be done, to have happened and to be performed precedent to and in the issuance of this note, has been done, has happened and has been performed in full and strict compliance with the Constitution and laws of the State of North Carolina and that this note is within every debt and other limit prescribed by law, and the faith and credit of County of Columbus arehereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the Principal and Interest of this note, according to its terms.
