A RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION AND CREATION OF A BUREAU OF IDENTIFICATION AND INVESTIGATION FOR COLUMBUS COUNTY.

It is hereby ordered by the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County at meeting held December 14, 1940:

1. That a Bureau of Indentification and Investigation shall be set up in comnection with the Sheriff's office of Columbus County.

2. That H. L. Shaw is hereby appointed Superintendent of the Bureau of Identification and Investigation.

3. That the duties of the said Superintendent shall be to fingerprint all persons arrested in the county of Columbus, by the Sheriff's department; That a copy of each fingerprint be forwarded to the Federal Bureau of Investigation at Washington, and to the North Carolina Bureau of Investigation in Raleigh, and a copy retained in the files of said Bureau; That it shall be the duty of the said Superinfindent to investigate all crimes committed in Columbus County, punishable as a fédony under the laws of the State of North Carolina and the United States of America, and to assist the Solicitor of the Recorder's Court of Columbus County, and the Solicitor of the Superior Court on the prosecution of actions, when he is requested to do so.

4. That the Superintendent shall be responsible to the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County.

5. That the salary of the Superintendent shall be \$65.00 per month, and shall begin on the 1st day of January, 1941, and his term of employment shall be at the pleasure of the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County.
