Ordered: that 8 hogs at County Home be vaccinated.

On motion of Bruce Pierce, seconded by J. C. Stanley, it is ordered that the balance in the Revolving Fund be transferred to the General County Fund.

Ordered: that if necessary, the Chairman of Board and the County Attorney, on Tuesday, January 14th, call on A.C.L. in Wilmington to collect taxes due by A.C.L., if possible.

On motion of A. W. Williamson, seconded by W. L. Hobbs, it is ordered that all still bills prior to January 6th be accepted as correct. It is further ordered that all future still bills be sworn to as prescribed by law.

Ordered: that I. C. Jordan be allowed to pay taxes on \$800 valuation for year 1939 instead of \$1,760, due to an error in listing.

Ordered: that A. W. Williamson be authorized to look into pump trouble at County Home and see what is needed to correct same.

Ordered: that Carlton Lindsey be allowed to pay Bert Stephens' taxes in Cerro Gordo Township for years 1928 to 1940 at 6% flat and 1/2 court cost.

On motion of W. L. Hobbs, seconded by A. W. Williamson, it is ordered that Chairman and Clerk be authorized to sign check for Revenue Anticipation Note due January 30, 1941, provided funds are on hand.

On motion of Bruce Pierce, seconded by J. C. Stanley, it is ordered that the County Auditor be paid \$200.00 per month, effective January 1st, 1941. All Commissioners vote "yes".

On motion of A. W. Williamson, seconded by W. L. Hobbs, it is ordered that bond on W. E. Harrelson, ^{former} Tax Collector, be cancelled and refund on same be obtained when W. E. Harrelson makes his settlement with the County. All Commissioners vote "yes".

Ordered: that action in appointing a coroner be deferred until regular meeting in February. The Clerk of Superior Court is to provide for emergencies as required by law.

RESOLUTION

Ordered: that the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars for General School purposes, same being renewal note.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General School purposes be executed in the sum of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars dated January 14, 1941, maturing July 14, 1941.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of 1 1/4 per-cent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at Central Hanover Bank and Trust Company, New York, New York, in anticipation of 1940 taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus,

Be it further ordered that the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.

NOTE

The County of Columbus, in the State of North Carolina, hereby acknowledges itself indebted and for value received promises to pay to the bearer in lawful money of the United States of America the sum of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars on the 14th day of July, 1941, with interest thereon from date at the rate of 1 1/4 per-cent per annum. Both principal and interest on this note are payable at Central Hanover Bank and Trust Company, New York, New York.

This note is issued pursuant to the County Finance Act, as amended, and a resolution duly adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of said County for necessary expenses and for the purpose of paying the principal or interest of bonds due or to become due within four months and not otherwise adequately provided for, and in anticipation of the receipt of taxes and other revenue of the current fiscal year.

It is hereby certified and recited that all acts, conditions and things required by the statutes and Constitution of the State of North Carolina to be performed, happen and exist precedent to and in the issuance of this note have been performed, have happened and exist, and that this note is within every debt and other limitation prescribed by said statutes and Constitution. For the prompt payment hereof, both principal and interest as the same fall due, the full faith and credit of said County are hereby irrevocably pledged.

In witness whereof, the said County of Columbus has caused this note to be signed by the Chairman of its Board of County Commissioners and by the Clerk of said Board and its corporate seal to be impressed hereon, all as of the 14th day of January, 1941.
