Ordered: that the securities in the amount of \$57,000.00 placed with the Wachovia Bank and Trust Company, Raleigh, N. C. by the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, Whiteville, N. C., be released; said securities having served their purpose, namely to secure a special account of the County of Columbus to that bank, representing proceeds from sale of certain refunding bonds, which account has been closed in accordance with instructions pertaining thereto.

Ordered: that Mr. W. H. Applewhite and Mr. Lacy Stanley be instructed that it is agreeable with the Board for them to accompany Mr. J. C. Wessell, Attorney for West Virginia Pulp and Paper Company, at his expense, in making a review of the valuations placed on the above properties.
