Minutes of the last meetings being read and approved, the following business was transacted.

Ordered: that M. M. Long, Nakina, N. C., be refunded \$1.00 penalty for late listing 1941 taxes, due to error in listing.

Ordered: that refunds Nos. 629 and 630 issued on November 6, 1939 to R. J. Long, Bug Hill Township, for \$3.56 for \$270 valuation for years 1937 and 1938 @ \$1.32 rate respectively, be approved and allowed provided 1937 and 1938 taxes are paid in full.

Ordered: that S. W. Smith, Williams Township, be allowed refund of \$5.36 on valuation of \$400 for year 1941, due to error in listing automobile.


