IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED AND RECITED that all acts, conditions and things required by the Statutes and Constitution of the State of North Earolina to be performed, happen and exist precedent to and in the issuance of this note have been performed, have happened and exist, and that this note is within every debt and other limitation prescribed by said statutes and Constitution. For the prompt payment hereof, both principal and interest as the same fall due, the full faith and credit of said County are hereby irrevocably pledged.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said County of Columbus has caused this note to be signed by the Chairman of its Board of County Commissioners and by the Clerk of said Board and its corporate seal to be impressed hereon, all as of the 21st day of April, 1942.

Ordered: that \$2,250.00 be advanced from the Revolving Fund to the General School Fund to supplement funds needed to retire debt service due May 1, 1942 and that School Fund check to Revolving Fund for refund thereof be issued, and held until funds are available for its clearance.

Ordered: that the balance in the Revolving Fund be transferred to the General County Fund after checks held against the Vocational Education Fund in the amount of \$5,500.00 and the School Fund in the amount of \$2,250.00 have cleared.

There being no further business, adjournment was voted in order until Monday, May 4, 1942.
