Ordered: that 25 acres listed by Foster L. Smith, Lees Township, be reduced to 17 acres and valued at \$560 for 1941 & 1942 and that 7½ acre tract be cut out due to error in listing and that the tax collector be issued refund therefor.

Ordered: that L. Byrd, Whiteville Township, be refunded on \$500 valuation

for 1942 taxes and that the tax supervisor be instructed to list 260 acre Bright 519 tract at a valuation of \$5,095 in 1943 instead of \$5595.

Ordered: that one \$1,000 Town of Fairmont Water and Sewer 6% bond No.17 due 7-1-42, placed with Wachovia Bank and Trust Company, Raleigh, N. C. by Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, Whiteville, N.
