

RESOLUTIONNo. 1

Ordered: that the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars for General County purposes, same being renewal note.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General County purposes be executed in the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars dated November 24, 1942, maturing March 24, 1943.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of Two and one-half ( $2\frac{1}{2}\%$ ) per cent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at First Citizens Bank and Trust Company, Raleigh, North Carolina, in anticipation of 1942 and prior years taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.

Be it further resolved that the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.

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
