Minutes of the last meeting being read and approved, the following business was transacted.

Ordered: that E. H. McKeithan, Chadbourn Township, property be reduced to \$1,000 for year 1942 due to error in listing, and that refund be issued for difference.

Ordered: that Willie A. White, Whiteville, N. C., be granted \$5.00 monthly relief.

Ordered: that J. David Bullard, Chadbourn, N. C., be exempted from paying Peddlers' license in Columbus County.

Ordered: that 120 acres Pierce tract, Bogue Township, valued at \$2250 listed for year 1942 by C. R. Holcomb, be segregated so that Mrs. Ola Pierce can pay taxes thereon, she having purchased same.

Ordered: that lots listed by Mary Davis, Whiteville Township, at \$600 for years 1942 and prior be valued at \$300 due to error in listing.

Ordered: that Easter Purdie be allowed to pay \$145.00 on foreclosed property, provided she will pay balance due in 12 months, payments of not less than \$25.00 to be made monthly; and, it is further ordered that the Town of Chadbourn be paid their claims against said Easter Purdie property.

Ordered: that Mr. John Wright be granted \$3.00 present relief.

Ordered: that 1936 tax O. G. Calhoun Estate be cancelled as it is doublelisted for said year, same being listed by Braxton, Ford and Nealy.

Ordered: that C. H. Hinson, Chadbourn Township taxes for 1938, 1939 and 1940 A. be cancelled for said years as same is listed to Myrtle/Bailey.

Ordered: that the S. P. Smith tax listed in Cerro Gordo Township on the white penalty list for 1940 be cancelled as it is double-listed.

Ordered: that no cost be allowed in the case of Columbus County VS R. L. Thompson and wife, and that non-suit be taken today.

C. by the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, county depository, for security of official county deposits, be approved and that 1-\$1,000 Town of Fairmont bond being No. 8 be released as requested by the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company.

Ordered: that the Chairman and the Clerk be authorized and instructed to

sign Revolving Fund check for \$15,746.91 transferring same to General County Fund.

Ordered: that the Chairman and the Clerk be authorized and instructed to sign Court House Bond Fund voucher for \$1253.13 to pay interest and exchange due 2-1-43 on 2-1-14 Court House Bonds.

Ordered: that B. L. Martin, Tax Collector, be required to deposit his tax collections daily with the Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, county depository, as Undistributed Tax Fund, to be disbursed only upon checks signed by the County Auditor and countersigned by the Tax Collector.
