The following business was transacted.

Ordered: that 1942 tax of the W. O. Burns Estate, Ransom Township, be allowed settled at par, due to mix-up in listing.

Ordered: that order authorizing the sale of the L. E. Anderson property on May 3rd, 1943 be rescinded and that said property be advertised in accordance with the statute and sold at public auction.

Ordered: that the County School Budget be accepted as follows:

Ordered: that $3 \frac{1}{3}$ acre tract William Stevens property, Lees Township, be segregated so that R. C. Stanley who has bought same can pay taxes there-on on a valuation of \$55.00 for the years 1929, 1931, 1932 and 1933 at par plus 6% and \$3.00 court cost.

Ordered: that D. C. Collins's 1937 and 1939 tax, Whiteville Township, be allowed settled at 6% flat.

Ordered: that tax of A. L. Best, Chadbourn Township, be cancelled for the years 1929, 1930, 1931, 1932, 1933, 1934, 1935, 1937, 1938, 1939, 1940 and 1941, as it was listed in the name of Jet Wortham.

Ordered: that one of the receipts of C. K. Dudney, Tatum Township, be cancelled for the year 1934 in the amount of \$5.73 as it was double-listed to him for that year and the other receipt has been paid.

Ordered: that Lonnie Sasser, Bogue Township, be allowed to settle 1933 and 1934 taxes at par plus 10% and \$6.00 court cost.

Ordered: that Pierce and Company, Bogue Township, be refunded on \$8,300 valuation for the years 1942 and 1943, due to error in listing.

Ordered: that tax collector be given General County check for \$2.99 to reimburse him for money paid to Lynn Clark for 1939 tax receipt #2569, Whiteville Township, the tax collector having paid to Clark, \$2.99 out of his cash drawer, and that a refund be issued the tax collector for Lynn Clark tax receipt for 1940, Whiteville Township, receipt #301; both of said years taxes being double-listed and ~~tax~~ Clark having paid one tax receipt for each of said years.

Ordered: that one room on first floor of jail be designated for the purpose of keeping juvenile prisoners so as to keep them separated from the regular prisoners.

Ordered: that the Chairman and the Clerk be authorized and instructed to sign Court House Bond Fund voucher in the amount of \$1,253.13 to pay interest and exchange due August 1, 1943.

Ordered: that Allen Boone and wife property in Bogue Township, secured by tax foreclosure, be sold to Annie Boone, Hallsboro, N. C. for \$83.09 and deed be executed therefor.

Ordered: that order passed Oct. 24, 1940 relative to Mrs. W. J. Cashwell property, Ransom Township, be corrected to read "Reduced from a valuation of \$1266 to \$866."

Ordered: that Foster Tart, Cerro Gordo, N. C., be given \$5.00 present relief.

Ordered: that Linwood Riley's 1942 Poll Tax, Ransom Township, be refunded due to his being in the armed forces.

RESOLUTION

No. 1

Ordered: that the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars for General School purposes, same being renewal note.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General School purposes be executed in the sum of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars dated July 14, 1943, maturing October 14, 1943.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of one and three-fourths (1 3/4%) percent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at First Citizens Bank and Trust Company, Raleigh, N. C., in anticipation of 1942 and prior years taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.

Be it further resolved that the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.

REVENUE ANTICIPATION NOTE

\$15,000.00

The County of Columbus, in the State of North Carolina, hereby acknowledges itself indebted and for value received promises to pay to the bearer in lawful money of the United States of America the sum of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars on the 14th day of October, 1943, with interest thereon from date at the rate of 1 3/4 percent per annum. Both principal of and interest on this note are payable at FIRST CITIZENS BANK AND TRUST COMPANY, RALEIGH, NORTH CAROLINA.

This note is issued pursuant to the County Finance Act, as amended, and a resolution duly adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of said County for necessary expenses and for the purpose of paying the principal or interest of bonds or notes due or to become due within four months and not otherwise adequately provided for, and in anticipation of the receipt of taxes and other revenue of the current fiscal year.

It is hereby certified and recited that all acts, conditions and things required by the statutes and Constitution of the State of North Carolina to be performed, happen and exist precedent to and in the issuance of this note have been performed, have happened and exist, and that this note is within every debt and other limitation prescribed by said statutes and Constitution. For the prompt payment hereof, both principal and interest as the same fall due, the full faith and credit of said County are hereby irrevocably pledged.

In witness whereof, the said County of Columbus has caused this note to be signed by the Chairman of its Board of County Commissioners and by the Clerk of said Board and its corporate seal to be impressed hereon, all as of the 14th day of July, 1943.
