The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that M. E. Reaves, Bolton Township, be refunded \$2.00 Poll tax for 1943 due to being past 50 years of age.

Ordered: that James Thomas Williams, col., Ransom Township, be admitted to County Home.

Ordered: that mileage be allowed coroner when no inquest is held.

Ordered: that the 38 acre tract W. A. Brown property, Ransom Township, valued \$1415 be segregated so that John William Brown can pay 1942 and 1943 tax on 10 acres at a valuation of \$715.

Ordered: that Court House employees be given November 11th as a holiday in observance of Armistice Day.

Ordered: that Kathleen Hayes, Assistant to Register of Deeds, be paid \$85.00 per month.

Ordered: that Sunday Lennon foreclosed property, Tatum Township, be sold to Blumy Patterson, Boardman, N. C. for \$48.15 and deed be executed therefor.

Ordered: that the tax in Ransom Township listed to Dr. Pepper Bottling Co. for 1943 be cancelled and the tax collector be issued a refund therefor as they did not own any property in Ransom Township, and that a refund of the tax on \$420 valuation be granted to Dr. Pepper Bottling Co. on the valuation of its property in Whiteville Township for the year 1943.

Ordered: that the taxes of J. E. Thompson and Co., Bogue Township, for the years 1941, 1942 and 1943 be segregated so that W. A. Thompson can pay on the 1 1/2 acres of W. E. Pope land with a valuation of \$420.

Ordered: that the tax collector settle with J. E. Thompson on W. E. Pope's taxes in Bogue Township for the years 1927 thru 1938, inclusive, upon the payment of the total sum of \$136.28, and that upon such payment, J. E. Thompson property is released from the lien of said taxes, and that the tax collector be granted a refund for the difference in the amount of said taxes.

Ordered: that the \$16.08 partial payment on the 1943 tax of Lollie Squires in Waccamaw Township paid by T. M. Brown on October 19, 1943 be accepted as payment in full of the tax on the 100 acre tract he purchased from Lollie Squires, said 100 acre tract of land being known as the R. E. Council Estate and valued at \$1200.

Ordered: that the bid of Columbus County at the tax foreclosure in the case of Columbus County VS Floyd Webb et al, be transferred to R. R. Moore, and the Commissioner appointed by the Court is hereby authorized to make a deed to R. R. Moore in lieu of Columbus County, upon the payment by said R. R. Moore to said Commissioner of the amount bid by Columbus County at said sale, to wit: \$82.22; and provided further that said R. R. Moore shall pay the 1943 tax of Floyd Webb in Bolton Township.

Ordered: that the bid of Columbus County at the tax foreclosure sale in the case of Columbus County VS C. P. Dagenhart et al, be transferred to R. R. Moore, and the Commissioner appointed by the Court therein is hereby authorized to make a deed to R. R. Moore in lieu of Columbus County, upon the payment by said R. R. Moore to said Commissioner of the amount bid by Columbus County at said sale, to wit: \$57.52.

Ordered: that the 1941, 1942 and 1943 tax of Albert E. Smith, Bolton Township, be cancelled and the tax collector be given a refund thereon as this property was also listed and paid in the name of C. L. Lingenfelter.

Ordered: that 1941 tax of Ed Jernigan in Williams Township be cancelled and the tax collector given a refund as it was double-listed to him for said year and he has paid one listing.

Ordered: that the 1935, 1936, 1937, 1938, 1942 and 1943 tax listed to Larry Wortham, Chadbourn Township, be cancelled as the same property has been listed to Leah Wortham, and that the tax collector be given a refund for said taxes.

Ordered: that the amounts paid on 1939, 1940 and 1941 tax of Larry Wortham, Chadbourn Township, be applied as a credit on Leah Wortham's taxes in Chadbourn Township, and that said amount of \$5.37 be refunded to the tax collector on Leah Wortham's 1941 tax.

Ordered: that 40 acre tract of land listed to Clarence Butler, Whiteville Township, valued at \$600 for year 1943, be reduced to \$400, due to being cut over.

Ordered: that J. A. Stanley, Williams Township, be issued a refund for \$1.00 for late listing penalty charged to him thru error.
