The following business was transacted.

Ordered: Casey Baldwin, Whiteville Township, 1941 Poll and Penalty be cancelled for 1941 and subsequent years due to physical disability.

Ordered: that J.R. Gerald Property, South Williams Township, County Owned thru foreclosure be sold for \$200.00 to Dewey Long, Tabor City and deed executed therefor.

Ordered: that H. Dow Tedder, Bogue Township be refunded by General County Fund Voucher for \$2.00 due to his being over 50 years.

Ordered: that J.W. Shaw's taxes Ransom Township be allowed settled for 1937 and prior years due, at par plus 6% and one-half the court cost provided subsequent taxes are paid.

Ordered: that Tax Collector be refunded 1944 Taxes for George F. Casteen, Chadbourn Township, due to error in listing. Party being a resident of Florence, S.C. for 1½ years.

Ordered: that 1935 tax listed to C.Q. Adams, Tatum Township be cancelled and Tax Collector refunded therefor as no such property exists.
