Ordered: that General County Fund voucher for \$2.97 (1944 Poll tax and late listing penalty on same) be issued to Shula Sellers, Chadbourn Township to reimburse him on same due to his having been in the armed Services.

Ordered: that 383 acres valued at \$9,360.00 in 1945 listed to Dawsey L. Coleman, Williams Township be reduced to $325\frac{1}{2}$ Acres and value be placed at \$8,900.00.

Ordered: that \$480.00 valuation on 4 acres J.P. Cribb track listed by J.C. Cribb, Williams Township, for 1944 be cancelled and that he be given General Fund Voucher for \$6.43 to refund him therefor due to being listed also as J.C. & M.V. Cribb land.
