

R E S O L U T I O N

The following business was transacted.

Ordered: that 10 acres of the County Farm be approved for Prison of War Camp site.

Ordered: that General County Fund voucher for \$2.97 (1944 Poll tax and late listing penalty on same) be issued to Shula Sellers, Chadbourn Township to reimburse him on same due to his having been in the armed Services.

Ordered: that 383 acres valued at \$9,360.00 in 1945 listed to Dawsey L. Coleman, Williams Township be reduced to 225 1/2 Acres and value be placed at \$8,900.00.

Ordered: that 20 acres valued at \$355.00 and listed to H.H. Bullock, Cerro Gordo Township for years 1943 and 1944 be refunded to him and tax for said years be charged to E.M. Barnes, Cerro Gordo Township due to his having bought same.

Ordered: that deed to the Mrs. Isham Hinson Wright property, Whiteville Township, County owned by tax foreclosure proceedings be executed and delivered to Marion Stephens upon the payment of \$132.76 and subject to 1945 taxes.

Ordered: that John H. Jones, 1940 tax in Whiteville Township be allowed settled on the 1941 valuation and the Tax Collector refunded on the difference thereon.

Ordered: that John B. Gore, Nakina, N.C. be given General County Voucher for \$2.00 for poll double listed in Bug Hill and Lees Township for year 1943.

Ordered: that \$480.00 valuation on 4 acres J.P. Cribb track listed by J.C. Cribb, Williams Township, for 1944 be cancelled and that he be given General Fund Voucher for \$6.43 to refund him therefor due to being listed also as J.C. & M.V. Cribb land.

Ordered: that Delco Colony known as New Berlin Colony now owned by Hugh McRae and Company, Wilmington, N.C. shall be reduced from \$20.00 per acre to \$10.00 per acre for tax listing for 1945 due to the lands being sold off leaving the unsold lands in branches and creeks thereby reducing the value of the unsold lands.

Ordered: that \$1,500.00 be advanced to the Town of Whiteville, as deposit for city water to be metered to the county Home by the said Town of Whiteville.

Ordered: that Chairman and Clerk be authorized to sign Debt Service check in the amount of \$768.16 to pay the following due March 1, 1945:

Ordered: that 1939, 1940 and 1942 taxes of Mamie Simmons be cancelled and the Tax Collector issued refunds thereon due to same being foreclosed to Columbus County and sold to John Carter.
