LEASE AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES
OF AMERICA

WHEREAS, the United States of America is desirous of obtaining from Columbus County a lease of a certain part of a tract or parcel of land containing approximately 10 acres, and being a part of the 62 acre tract described in a deed from Patience Brown to D.C. Hight, et al, Commissioners of Columbus County, said deed being dated 20 December 1887 and recorded 21 December 1887 in Deed Book No.GG, page No. 186, in the office of the Register of Deeds for Columbus County, for the purpose of establishing a Prisoner of War Camp.

WHEREAS, said property is not now being used for governmental purposes by Columbus County and , by law in such cases made and provided, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Columbus is authorized and empowered to lease said property, and the Board of Commissioners being of the opinion that it is to the best interest of Columbus County to enter into said lease agreement:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Columbus County enter into a lease agreement with the United States of America providing for the leasing of the above mentioned property for a term not to extend six months beyond the termination of the unlimited National Emergency for a consideration of \$1.00 per annum, receipt acknowledged; that J.L. Robinson, Chairman of the Board of Commissioners for the County of Columbus, is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute said lease agreement for and in behalf of Columbus County, and the Secretary of the Board is authorized and directed to attest same and place thereon the seal of Columbus County, and said lease agreement shall be in full force and effect, if and when signed by the United States of America.
