Ordered: that \$3,000.00 be appropriated for the Department of Conservation and Development Division of Forestry for fiscal year 1945-1946.

Ordered: that the salary of H.L. Shaw, Finger Print Expert, be \$125.00 per month effective as of April 1, 1945 and adjustment be made accordingly, the \$25.00 increase to represent travel allowance.

Ordered: that the James Mayo property, County Owned by tax

foreclosure procedure be sold to N. C. Watts and Wife Mary I. for \$80.00 and that M.K. Fuller, Trustee be authorized to execute deed therefor.

Martin present Tax Collector be relieved of all uncollected tax receipts, landsale certificates and other items of the office and that W.D.
