Ordered: that Andrew Reaves be allowed to settle 1935 taxes, Whiteville Township for \$4.31.

Ordered: that \$1363 valuation listed to Clyde Tyree, Whiteville Township for year 1945 be cancelled due to error and that he be refunded \$19.76 by General County Fund Voucher as he has paid taxes on same.

Ordered: that V.E. Pierce be allowed to settle taxes for 1937 and prior listed to F.B. Pierce Estate, Bogue Township, at par plus 6% and one-half Court Cost.

WHEREAS, the attached petition has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Columbus requesting that the above described road, the location of which has been indicated in red on the attached map, be added to the system of county roads now maintained by the State Highway and Public Works Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after careful investigation, deems the proposed addition of said road to the County Road System and its maintenance by the State Highway and Public Works Commission necessary to adequately serve the citizens of said County.

NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.

Ordered: that listing to W.E. Straw, Bolton Township, for year 1945 be cancelled due to error and the Tax Collector be refunded therefor. It is further ordered that Tax Supervisor enter a late listing for 1945 on a \$200 valuation to W.E. Straw in Bolton Township and that the Tax Collector be charged with said receipt for collection.

Ordered: that 1945 listing of \$2250 valuation on 1 lot of F.T. Richardson, Chadbourn Township, be cancelled due to error and that the Tax Collector be refunded therefor.

Beginning at John Meredith House on the Wilmington-Fayetteville Highway, and leads in a Southeasterly direction to the old Lake road where it turns to go toward Freeman, near the Mike Rawls Place; and there should be a short spur to connect this proposed road with the road that leads to the Fayetteville highway, near the tobacco barn of Mrs. A.B. Love, Postmistress at Armour.

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WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after careful investigation, deems the proposed addition of said road to the County Road System and its maintenance by the State Highway and Public Works Commission necessary to adequately serve the citizens of said county.

NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.

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Community road that runs into the Rough and Ready road which runs from Fair Bluff to Wards Station. This road is a distance of one mile and one-tenth which leads from the L.D.Floyd farm where Haynes Hilbourn now resides and leads by the residence of Gomery Hilbourn, etal into the rough and ready road as stated above.

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NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.

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The state road traveled by the School bus and U.S. mail and known as the Acme to Neils Eddy road be extended from C.W. FormyDuval residence to Brunswick County line at L.W. Barbar's residence 1/2 mile. Also widen where necessary as it is too narrow in place for safety.

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NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.

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Beginning at a point on the Mollie and Tabor Highway near Carson Garrells home and run then near south east to a point on the Tabor City and Nakina highway.

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Road leading from Avant & Sholar's junk yard on the Whiteville - Tabor City highway in Whiteville Township to Mrs. Georgia Thompson's residence on the road leading to the Slippery log road, being a distance of approximately 1.3 Miles.

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NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.

This road leaves the highway near J.C.Ward's and runs through G.T.Ward's Norman Ward's and W.T. Anderson's fields and back to the highway near Q.B. Long's.

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NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.
