Resolution passed by Board of County Commissioners requesting Honorable R.Gregg Cherry to give Columbus County a two weeks Special Term of Criminal Court

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, Clifton L. Moore, District Solicitor, finds it necessary to request the Board of Columbus County Commissioners to ask the Governor to give us a two weeks Special Criminal Term of court for Columbus County in October.

WHEREAS, this has been made necessary by the great number of murder cases we have had this year and the general increase in crime. We have a first degree Murder case to try. The man is now in Georgia, but we are extraditing him. Besides, we have about forty cases left which need to be tried. In the meantime there will be a large accumulation of cases,

THEREFORE, for the sake of economy and, to clear the docket rather than to wait until the docket gets beyond control be it resolved that His Excellency, the Governor, be requested to grant this Special Term of two weeks court beginning October 14, 1946.

Ordered: that J.T. Danford, Whiteville, N.C., be allowed Fire Works Privilege License for year 1946-1947 at \$50.00/

Ordered: that \$7,000.00 of personal property valuation listed for year 1946 in error by George H. Batten, Whiteville Township, be cancelled; and it is further ordered that General County Fund Voucher be issued Mr. Batten as refund for said cancellation less  $1\frac{1}{2}\%$  allowed on 7-30-46 the date said taxes were paid.

Ordered: that Odis Inman be allowed \$5.00 per month instead of \$3.00 for immediate relief effective as of September 1, 1946.

Ordered: that County departments be authorized to operate their offices on a skeleton force on Farmer's Day, October 16, 1946.

Ordered: that the tax note of Mrs. T.C. Powell and Mrs. Bessie Tucker for the 1923, 1924, 1925, 1926, 1927, 1928, 1929, 1930 and 1931 tax in Tatum Township be cancelled as this property has been foreclosed by the County for taxes, this property is the 100 acres known as the J.C. Powell Estate and that the tax Collector be relieved of same; and, it is further ordered that taxes listed to said parties for years 1944 and 1945 be cancelled in the amounts of 98¢ and \$9.25 respectively, due to said foreclosure, and that the Tax Collector be granted refunds therefor.

Ordered: that 1929 tax listed to Stephen Inman in Chadbourn Township be cancelled and non-suit be taken as it was dropped from the tax books in 1930 without any explanation, and after a search of the records no such land can be found and it is apparent that it is the same as a 12 acre tract listed to Stephen Inman on which the tax has been paid.

Ordered: that 1935 and 1936 taxes listed to J.A. Reaves, Ransom Township, be cancelled and non-suit be taken as this property was double listed to Lillian Justice Reaves Curley and same as been paid by her.

Ordered: that 1939, 1940, 1941 and 1942 taxes listed in Tatum Township in the name of General Bryant be cancelled and the tax collector granted a refund for same as this property was double listed to Archie Shaw and the tax paid thereon.
