ORDER AUTHORIZING \$1,000,000 SCHOOL BUILDING BONDS.

WHEREAS, the Trustees of the Whiteville City Administrative Unit have certified to this Board a resolution passed by said Trustees on October 24, 1946 showing that it is necessary in order to maintain the constitutional six months' school term in said Whiteville City Administrative Unit to provide the school improvements mentioned in said resolution; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Education of Columbus County has certified to this Board a resolution passed by said County Board of Education on February 3, 1947 showing that it is necessary in order to maintain the constitutional six months, school term in the Columbus County Administrative Unit to provide the school improvements mentioned in said resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for the County of Columbus has carefully examined the facts and has determined and hereby finds as a fact that it has become the duty of said Board of Commissioners, acting as an administrative agent of the State in providing a State system of public schools, to order the issuance of a sufficient amount of County bonds to provide the school improvements mentioned in said resolutions, in order to maintain the constitutional six months' school term in Columbus County; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Columbus:

l. That, pursuant to the County Finance Act, as amended, bonds of Columbus County be issued in an amount not exceeding \$1,000,000 for the purpose of providing funds for erecting, remodeling and enlarging school buildings, including the acquisition of necessary land and equipment, in order to maintain the constitutional six months' school term in Columbus County, as follows:

WHITEVILLE CITY ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT:

District No. 7, Hallsboro School
District No. 9, Old Dock-Nakina School
District No. 10, Guideway School
District No. 13, AccestDelce School

Erecting new school buildings at the following schools and remodeling the existing school buildings:

District No. 11, Tabor City School District No. 12, Williams Township School Erecting senior high: school building for negro children at Chadbourn and at Hallsboro

Remodeling and enlarging school buildings for negro children in the Columbus County Administrative Unit.

2. That a tax sufficient to pay the principal and interest of said bonds when due shall be annually levied and collected.

3. That a statement of the County debt has been filed with the Clerk and is open to public inspection.

4. That this order shall take effect when approved by the voters of the County at an election as provided by law.

The Board thereupon designated the Clerk of Superior Court as the officer to file with the Clerk the statement of debt and assessed valuation required by the County Finance Act, as amended, to be filed before the final passage of the bond order this/introduced.

Thereupon the Clerk of Superior Court filed with the Clerk, in the presence of the Board, the statement of debt and assessed valuation as required by Section 13 of the County Finance Act.

The order authorizing \$1,000,000 School Building Bonds was thereupon passed on first reading.

And thereupon the Board fixed 2:00 O'clock, P.M., February 17, 1947, as the hour and date for the public hearing as required by Section 16 of the County Finance Act, and directed the Clerk to publish the bend order which has been introduced this day, together with the appended note as required by Section 16, of said Act, in The News-Reporter, not later than the 10th day before said date.
