Mr. A.W. Williamson introduced the following resolution which was read at length:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING \$25,000 REVENUE ANTICIPATION NOTES OF THE COUNTY OF COLUMBUS FOR MEETING APPROPRIATIONS

Whereas, insufficient revenues for meeting appropriations of the current fiscal year ending June 30, 1947, have not been collected and

Whereas, the County Accountant has certified to the Board that the amount of the taxes levied for such current fiscal year which remain uncollected as of April 7, 1947, is \$52,666.00, and that the County owes no indebtedness evidencing money borrowed for the purpose of meeting appropriations, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Columbus, North Carolina:

Section 1. That it is necessary for the County of Columbus to borrow money under the provisions of Section 153-72 of the General Statutes of North Carolina and in order to perfect such borrowing, a negotiable note or notes of the County of the aggregate principal amount of \$25,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to the County Finance Act.

Section 2. That the notes herein authorized shall be dated April 25, 1947, shall mature July 30, 1947, shall bear interest from their date, payable at maturity, at a rate not exceeding 6% per annum. The denomination or denominations, the place of payment of principal and interest and the rate of interest of said notes, provided such rate shall be within the limitation fixed herein, shall be determined by the Local Government Commission.

Section 3. That the County Accountant is hereby authorized and directed to make application to the Local Government Commission requesting its approval of the issuance of the notes herein authorized and requesting said Commission to advertise such notes for sale in the manner provided by law.

Section 4. That upon sale of the notes herein authorized, the Chairman and Clerk of the Board are hereby directed to execute said notes and to turn the same over to the Local Government Commission for delivery to the purchasers through the State Treasurer.

Mr. A.W. Williamson, made the motion that the foregoing resolution be adopted. The motion was seconded by Mr. Bud Stephens and said resolution was adopted by the following roll call vote:

On motion of Commissioner W.A. Weir and seconded by Commissioner W.F. Floyd, it is ordered that Senate bill No. 71, passed in the 1947 Session of the Legislature appointing W.D. Brooks, County Auditor and imposing certain additional duties upon him by law and he is to carry on his duties as follows:

1. Tax Supervisor
2. Tax Collector
3. Purchasing Agent
4. Supervise the operation and maintenance of the County Home and County Farm.

Ordered: that Rosier Williams resignation as County Farm Supt. not be accepted.

Ordered: that Commissioner A.W. Williamson Chairman Pro Tem be allowed to sign checks and invoices for March bills due to the illness of Chairman L.P. Ward.

On motion of Commissioner W.A. Weir, seconded by Commissioner W.F. Floyd, it is ordered that all Real Estate valuation be increased ten percent (10%).

Ordered: that all land upon which taxes have not been paid be advertised and sold the first Monday in June, and that notice of said sale days be advertised in the paper according to statute.

Whereas, in the case of Columbus County vs. Joe Mojzer, et al, which was an action brought to foreclose tax lien, a sale was made by R.B. Mallard, Commissioner, on February 24, 1947, and the land described in the judgment rendered in said cause was sold to Columbus County for \$186.57, which said amount equals the amount of the tax lien against the land and the costs of the action; it is therefore,

Ordered, that a refund be given the tax collector for the 1929, 1930, 1931, 1932, 1933, 1934, 1935, 1936, 1937, 1938, 1939, 1940, 1941, 1942, 1943 1944, 1945, and 1946, tax of Joe Mojzer in Ransom Township and that the tax collector thereupon give the tax receipts to R.B. Mallard, Commissioner appointed in said action who shall attach said tax receipts to the deed for the land and give same to the County Auditor.

It is further ordered that a check for \$31.57 costs in said action be issued to the Clerk of Superior Court of Columbus County.

It is further ordered that the deed for said lands be recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds.
