\$20,000 Revenue Anticipation
Note

Mr. A. W. Williamson introduced the following resolution which was read at length:

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING \$20,000 REVENUE ANTICIPATION NOTES
OF THE COUNTY OF COLUMBUS**

WHEREAS, the County of Columbus has due and Payable \$25,732.50 of principal and interest of the following described bond issues evidencing indebtedness either incurred or assumed by said County:

WHEREAS, payment of such principal and interest is not otherwise adequately provided for and it is necessary that the County borrow money of the minimum amount of \$20,000 for such payment, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Columbus, North Carolina:

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 153-73 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the same being a part of the County Finance Act, and for the purpose stated in the preambles of this resolution a negotiable note or notes of the County of Columbus of the aggregate principal amount of \$20,000 are hereby authorized to be issued.

Sec. 2. That said notes shall be dated June 25, 1947, shall bear interest from date at a rate not exceeding six per centum per annum payable at maturity, and shall mature October 25, 1947.

Sec. 3. That the County Accountant is hereby authorized and directed to make application to the Local Government Commission requesting its approval of issuance of the notes herein authorized and requesting said commission to advertise said notes for sale in the manner provided by law.

Sec. 4. That the officers of the County herein authorized to execute said notes are hereby authorized and directed to fix the denomination or denominations of said notes the interest rate and the place of payment of principal and interest.

Sec 5. That, upon sale of the notes herein authorized by the Local Government Commission, the Chairman and Clerk of the Board are hereby authorized and directed to execute said notes and cause the corporate seal of the County to be impressed thereon and to cause the same to be turned over to the Local Government Commission for delivery to the purchasers through the State Treasurer of North Carolina.

CHANGE IN COUNTY ROAD

WHEREAS, the State Highway and Public Works Commission has filed with the Board of Commissioners of the County of Columbus a map designated as the Bladenboro - Whiteville road, showing a proposed relocation of a section of county road; and

WHEREAS, it appears that this relocation is for the best interest of the road system of the said county;

NOW, THEREFORE, the proposed change and relocation as shown on the said map is hereby approved and ratified.
