Ordered: that the valuation of house and lot of Mr. Greer Wright, Chadbourn Township, be reduced to \$450 for 1947, and that the tax collector be granted a refund for the remainder of this valuation which is the tax on \$1310.

Ordered: that upon the payment by H. G. Fields of all the taxes in Tatum Township of F. S. Floyd, Jr., beginning with and since 1939 plus one-half of the court cost, that all taxes listed in the name of F. S. Floyd, Jr. for the year 1938 and all prior years be cancelled and the tax collector be granted a refund therefore.
