Ordered: that the Chairman and Clerk be authorized to sign Bond Interest and Redemption Fund Voucher in the amount of \$662.90 to pay the following Debt Service due March 1, 1948:

REQUEST FOR ADDITION

OF

STATE MAINTAINED COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the attached petition has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of the county of Columbus requesting that the above described road; the location of which has been indicated in red on the attached map, be added to the system of county roads now maintained by the Stat Highway and Public Works Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after careful investigation, deems the proposed addition of said road to the County Road System and it maintenance by the State Highway and Public Works Commission necessary to adequately serve the citizens of said county.

NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take said road over for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.

Ordered: that the 1933 tax listed in the name of Ellen Myers Hemmingway, Lees Township, be segregated so that Hohinnie Bellamy, Jr. may pay on one-half of the tax plus penalty, so that his 23 acre tract may be released from tax lien.

Ordered: that the 1938, 1939, 1940, 1941 taxes listed in the name of Richard Leggett, Lees Township be cancelled as this property was double listed to H.C. Hill for these years, and the tax collector be granted refund.

Ordered: that the 1930, 1931 tax listed in the name of Algie Coggins Estate, Waccamaw Township, be cancelled and the tax Collector granted a refund as this was put on the books through error and non-suit be taken.
