Ordered: that \$10.00 be contributed to The Caswell Training School to help out with the Christmas Santa Claus.

Ordered: that the Court House be closed Thursday, Dec. 23 at 12:00 Noon through Saturday, Dec. 25 for the Christmas Holidays.

Ordered: that the Court House be closed Jan. 1, 1949, for New Years Day.

Ordered: that 1937 & prior years taxes of Mrs. M. J. Powell Heirs, Williams Township, be allowed settled at par and court cost cancelled and non-suit be taken provided all taxes on said estate are paid in full.

Ordered: that Jack Saunders be allowed the privilege of buying scrap iron for re-sale in Columbus County without license on account of him being a disabled World War I Veteran.

Ordered: that a new deed from Columbus County/<sup>be</sup>made to John L. Lennon, trustee for Earnest Lennon, to re-place deed which has been lost.

1. Have the Peacock Public road leading from the Beaver Dam Baptist Church, North to join the hard-surface road at Sims Frink leading from Chadbourn, N. C. This is one of the most important farm roads in Columbus County, it leading from one of the largest strawberry sections to Chadbourn Strawberry market.
2. Road from A. Q. Moore's residence on the state road lead-in from Portersville School to the Hallsboro and Elkton Road leading off from the said State Road and extending a distance of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles back to the Elkton and Hallsboro road be improved and put in a passable condition.
