The following business was transacted:

On motion of Commissioner W. F. Floyd seconded by Commissioner D. H. Jordan, it is ordered that the Electrical Inspectors of Columbus County be requested to meet with the Board of County Commissioners at their regular meeting, April 4, 1949. It is further ordered that Mr. D. S. Nichols, Field Representative, be requested to meet with the stated groups at this time.

Ordered: that Barbee Strickland, R-2, Tabor City, Cerro Gordo Township, be exempt poll tax in Columbus County because of physical disability.

Ordered: that present relief be given Mrs. James McComb, and Mrs. Nettie Nobles for \$ 5.00 each.

Motion was made by Commissioner D. H. Jordan that Mrs. Johnsie R. Nunn's checks be released for payment of services rendered in the capacity of Superintendent of Welfare, Columbus County. No second to this motion was heard.

Motion was made by Commissioner D. H. Jordan and carried and is hereby ordered that the salary of the Sheriff of Columbus County be increased to \$4,000 yearly and that the salary of the second, third and fourth deputies and fingerprint expert be raised \$30.00 per month. The first deputy's salary to be set by recommendation of the Sheriff with a \$25.00 limit per month. - These raises to be effective immediately.

Ordered: that Dr. Floyd Johnson, County Health Officer, be allowed to serve Brunswick County one day a week through June 30, 1949.

Ordered: that the Board of County Commissioners go along with the Trustees of the Whiteville City Schools in asking the Board of Elections to set a date for the vote of a 20¢ Special School Levy in the Whiteville area.

Ordered: that application of L. V. Molt, Tabor City, as electrical inspector for that district be approved by the Board of Commissioners and forwarded to William P. Hodges, Commissioner of Insurance, North Carolina Insurance Dept., Raleigh, N. C.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County that the Board unanimously request the State Highway and Public Works Commission to discontinue the maintenance and upkeep of that section of road beginning at Ward's Service Station across from the Atlantic Coast Line Depot in Bolton and running North to the intersection with the state maintained road near Gum Swamp a distance of 0.9 miles.

1. Road leading from the Tabor City - Pireway Road, at Hardee's station at Sandy Plains to the Iron Hill Road at Walter Gore's Home.
2. Section of road leading from Pireway highway at Braddy Norris Service Station --- to Iron Hill and Dothan Road being only Two-Tenths (2/10) of a mile.
3. Road leading from Tom Rhoad's home to the Hallsboro road at the name of Penn Summersett. This road is about one-half mile long. There are four families on the road and six school children who have to walk in and out to meet the school bus.
4. From the White Hall road, near Kerns Spaulding's Home, to the one coming by Farmers Union School a distance of about one and one half miles. For your information the stumps have been removed from each side of this road for the distance mentioned.
5. Beginning at a point on N. C. 410 near the home of J. J. Hester and running at a North easterly direction via home of I. O. Lowry and others and connect with a county road near the home of V. D. Brown.
6. Take over the upkeep and maintenance of a road beginning at the interseption of 9th Street with the truck land and running with said street to the Railroad; thence with Curtice Street to its intersection with the "Akatoka road near the Thurston farm, being a distance of 0.7 miles.

REQUEST FOR ADDITION
OF

STATE MAINTAINED COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the attached petition has been filed with the Board of County Commissioners of the county of Columbus requesting that the above described road, the location of which has been indicated in red on the attached map, be added to the system of county roads now maintained by the State Highway and Public Works Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after careful investigation, deems the proposed addition of said road to the County Road System and its maintenance by the State Highway and Public Works Commission necessary to adequately serve the citizens of said county.

NOW, THEREFORE, the State Highway and Public Works Commission is requested to take over said road for maintenance and the addition of said road and revisions in location deemed necessary by the State Highway and Public Works Commission are hereby approved.
