

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office April 4, 1949, it being First Monday.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that Polly Strickland, R-2, Tabor City, be allowed \$ 5.00 present relief.

Ordered: that order relating to a transfer of \$ 2,500 from General County Fund to Columbus County Schools Capital Outlay, passed Feb. 7, 1949, and recorded on page 543 in Minute Book No. 12 be rescinded and the School Capital Outlay check for \$2,500 be accepted in settlement.

Ordered: that \$ 3,100 be advanced from General County Fund to Columbus County General School Vocational Education Fund - this amount to be used in supplement of teachers wages as passed on by the State. This amount to be replaced from the 1949-1950 budget.

On motion of Commissioner D. H. Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Bud Stephens, it is ordered that the Electrical Inspectors of Columbus County be confined to their stated territories as appointed by the Commissioners in the various districts.

Ordered: that Early Loyless, Chadbourn Township, be exempt poll tax in Columbus County as he is a disabled veteran.

Ordered: that the Health Dept. be guaranteed a payment not to exceed \$ 500.00 to be used in the Malaria Control Project, according to the agreement with Dr. Floyd Johnson.

Ordered: that the County pay \$ 20.00 on redraft of map as shown in book V - 1 page 370 and recorded in Register of Deeds Office, Columbus County.

Ordered: that Mrs. Bud Johnson be allowed \$ 10.00 immediate relief and that check be made payable to Mrs. D. W. Wimberly, Agt. for Mrs. Bud Johnson.

Ordered: that Herman C. Williams be granted refund of late listing penalty for Mrs. Evelyn R. Williams, 1948 taxes in Lees Township for \$ 1.00 - receipt # 881; Herman C. Williams, Lees Township, for \$ 5.61 - receipt # 882; and Herman C. & Irvin Williams, Lees Township for \$ 2.18 - receipt # 883.

Ordered: that Representative J. K. Powell be requested to legislate on rates for Register of Deeds as set up in schedule submitted by Leo L. Fisher, Register of Deeds.

Ordered: that the Veterans of Foreign Wars of Tabor City be allowed to sponsor one show without tax during the month of April, 1949.

Ordered: that the 1933 tax listed in the name of N. B. Roberts Estate, Bolton Township, be cancelled and the tax collector granted a refund as the tax records show that this has been released and also court cost be cancelled and non-suit be taken.

Ordered: that the 1926 through 1940 tax listed in the name of Susan Lacewell, Ransom Township, be cancelled and tax collector granted refund as this was listed in error during these years, and non-suit be taken and court cost cancelled.

Ordered: that 1948 value on H. E. Floyd, Fair Bluff Township, inventory be reduced \$ 615.00 and that tax collector be granted refund for \$ 10.76.

Ordered: that order passed March 7, 1949, in reference to taxes of Leroy L. Gore in Whiteville Township, and recorded on Page 549 in Minute Book No. 12 be rescinded. It is further ordered that the 1948 tax in Whiteville Township, listed to Leroy L. Gore, be segregated so that upon the payment of the tax plus penalty on \$ 1,000.00 personal property valuation and \$ 110.00 real estate valuation, the two lots that Leroy L. Gore purchased from Leslie Thompson be released from the lien of said tax; said lots being valued at \$ 110.00.

Ordered: that the Chairman and Clerk be authorized to sign Bond Interest & Redemption Fund Vouchers in the amount of \$ 26,396.42 to pay the following due May 1, 1949:
